**TARIFF ESR-08  
ENERGY SAVING RATE**

**AVAILABILITY**

Available to all members who qualify for residential service receiving single phase service through a single meter.

**TYPE OF SERVICE**

Single-phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltage. Equipment subject to automatic load management controls.

**APPLICATION**

Service for small farm and home uses such as cooking, lighting, heating, etc. Limited to single phase loads.

**BASIC CHARGE:** \$28.75

**ENERGY CHARGE:**

On Peak (6 a.m.- noon) – First 1,500 kWh @ \$0.1198 per kWh  
Over 1,500 kWh @ \$0.1318 per kWh

Off Peak (noon - 6 p.m.) – First 1,500 kWh @ \$0.0417 per kWh  
Over 1,500 kWh @ \$0.0562 per kWh

Off Peak (6 p.m.- 6 a.m.) – First 1,500 kWh @ \$0.0417 per kWh  
Over 1,500 kWh @ \$0.0562 per kWh

**MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE**

The minimum monthly charge, under the above rate, shall be \$28.75 per month or prorated if service is provided for less than a full month.

**WHOLESALE POWER COST ADJUSTMENT**

A surcharge or credit may be applied to each billing for service under this tariff to reflect increases or decreases in the wholesale cost of power based on the rates charged by the Bonneville Power Administration.

**GENERAL PROVISIONS**

1. Member agrees to allow the cooperative, at its discretion, to install automatic load management controls.
2. The rated capacity of any motor served under this tariff shall be as follows:
  - Motors up to 2 HP can operate at 115 volts.
  - Motors larger than 2 HP shall operate at 230 volts and are subject to requirements in Member Service Policy 3-Technical Provisions.
3. No single resistive loads (examples: ovens, heaters, kilns) over 15 kW shall come on line simultaneously.
4. Non-resistive loads such as arc welders, fluorescent or mercury lamps, and induction heating furnaces are causes of harmonic distortion and may require corrective measures.
5. This rate class will be used to serve those members currently being served on the Residential Time of Day and Residential Off Peak rates.
6. Loads served under this tariff shall not be capable of being switched to another meter served under a different tariff.
7. See Member Services Policy 3-Technical Provisions for additional requirements.
