**TARIFF IN 3-05
INTER-ISLAND TRANSPORT**

AVAILABILITY

Available to Island Network members, including but not limited to non-profit public entities, wholesale providers, commercial and residential members subject to the General Provisions hereunder in this tariff. Inter-island transport service for commercial and residential members will be provided through an approved Island Network retail service provider.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Ethernet inter-island transport, measured in megabits per second (Mbps), between Island Network point of presence (POP) locations, which include San Juan County and Fidalgo Island.

APPLICATION

Ethernet inter-island transport for non-profit public entities, wholesale providers, commercial, and residential uses.

The minimum monthly charge is based on the applicable inter-island transport fees above, or prorated if inter-island transport service is provided for less than a full month.

COST BASED SYSTEM

A surcharge or credit may be applied to the inter-island transport fees under this tariff to reflect an increase or decrease in the cost of delivery. The surcharge or credit will be determined by Island Network management.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. A \$100.00 non-recurring configuration fee per VLAN will be charged.
2. Approved Island Network retail service providers shall have the authority to resell inter-island transport service to commercial and residential subscribers. Members other than approved Island Network retail service providers shall not resell inter-island transport services.
3. Members shall not provide any unauthorized access to the network. Island Network reserves the right to inspect for such third party access. If a violation is discovered, service will be terminated immediately and restitution for damages may be pursued at the discretion of Island Network staff.
4. This tariff does not include charges for an Island Network port, which is required for inter-island transport delivery.
5. Applicable taxes will apply.
