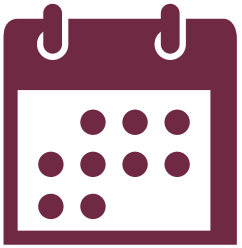


WAYS TO PAY



Auto Pay

Payments are automatically deducted from your bank account, credit card or debit card before the due date. Sign up for the service online or by phone.



Online via SmartHub

Pay your bill online with your bank account, credit card, or debit card. Click on the Pay Your Bill section of the website. You will need your account number and valid email address to set up an account. Track your usage, outages on your meter, and schedule payments for a date you prefer! Call us if you need help!



Phone

Pay your bill anytime, day or night, using our automated phone system. Have your account number handy.



Mail

Send a check made payable to OPALCO along with your bill in the envelope provide. Be sure to write you account number on your check.



In Person Payments are Temporarily Suspended
