Governor Inslee will likely be lifting the moratorium on all utility disconnects on July 31, 2021. Since the start of the pandemic, OPALCO has worked with members to offer additional assistance and long term payment plans for members behind on their power bills.

Members with payment plans will not be disconnected! Our goal is to get every member who needs one on a

On your bill this month you will see your capital credits allocation for 25 years from now (2046). As a member of an electric co-op, you earn capital credits. How does it work?

How capital credits work *at-a-glance.*



Become a co-op member.



OPALCO tracks how much a member pays into the co-op for power each year.

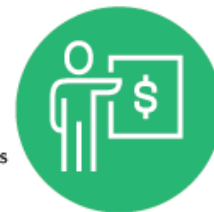


In June of each year (or following our financial audit) capital credits are allocated based on the calculation in Member Services Policy 11.

25 years later: Members receive their capital credit check. For example: In 2019, we distributed ~\$1.3 million to active members for FY 1994-95.

At year end, the Board determines if financial conditions will allow for distribution of capital credits to members who paid in 25 years ago.



In 2018, OPALCO started utilizing a "smoothing methodology," to ensure general retirements are as even as possible and plan for bigger margins.
