



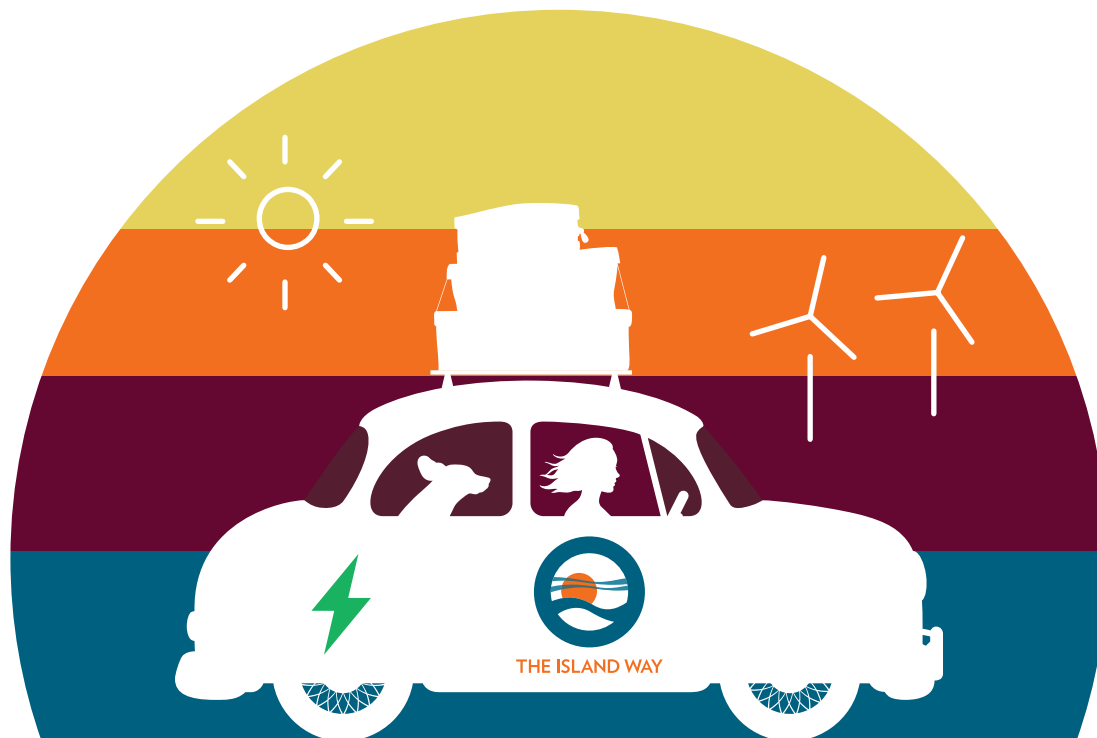
Call us today!
